ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Beacon warrants for the original purchaser against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for one year after date of shipment (not to exceed 18 months after date of manufacture). Any part that is determined by the manufacturer to be defective in material or workmanship and returned to the factory, will be, as the exclusive remedy, repaired or replaced at Beacon option. Labor costs for warranty repairs and/ or modifications are not covered unless pre-approved by Beacon. Any modifications performed without prior written approval of Beacon may void warranty. This limited warranty gives purchaser specific legal rights which vary from state to state.

All specifications are subject to change without notice.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

To the extent allowable under applicable law, Beacon's liability for consequential and incidental damages is expressly disclaimed. The manufacturer's liability in any event is limited to, and shall not exceed, the purchase price paid. Misuse or modification may void warranty.
